Mosel lands solar-cell orders from Tynsolar

Mosel Vitelic announced that it has landed a three-year solar cell contract with solar module maker Tynsolar.

Under the contract, Mosel will supply NT\$2.6 billion (US\$82.9 million) worth of 6-inch multi-crystalline solar cells to Tynsolar during 2009-2011. Mosel is currently running on an annual capacity of 60 peak megawatt (MWp).

The company started construction on its plant in May 2008 with volume production expected to take place in the fourth quarter of 2008. This new production plant is designed on a capacity of 200MWp. Mosel plans to add two lines with each to deliver 50MWp of capacity in the first-phase of capacity installation.
