JA Solar Mired in Class Action Suit Over Lehman Investment RECEN Aliba Email to friend Posted on Jan 09, 2009 | 18:01 BOE China China Dyer & Berens LLP announced on Friday that it has filed a U.S. class action lawsuit against solar cell Hand manufacturer JA Solar Holdings Co. Ltd. (Nasdaq: JASO) over the solar company's failure to disclose the purchase of a \$100 million note from a subsidiary of the now-defunct Lehman Brothers in July. Dyer & Touc Berens LLP claims the company's failure to report the note resulted in misleading financial guidance and Sunt has filed the suit in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York on behalf of Shan purchasers of the company's American Depository Shares from August 12 to November 12. Izard Nobel LLP announced that a class action suit had been filed against JA Solar on December 3, 2008, and Scott+Scott Gom LLP announced that they had filed suit on December 31. Shan Including a \$100 million impairment charge for the note, JA Solar recorded a net loss of \$21 million in the third quarter of 2008, compared to net income of \$24.4 million and \$46.9 million in the year- and quarterago periods.
