## Wind: onshore (>100kW) - Business news Econcern enters Chinese wind sector

POZNAN, POLAND, December 9, 2008. Econcern has announced agreements to invest €863 million in onshore wind farms in China representing over 720 MW of energy capacity.

Econcern has signed term sheets for three onshore wind farm projects with CNOOC New Energy, a full subsidiary of <a href="China National Offshore Oil Corporation">China National Offshore Oil Corporation</a>, and for one onshore wind farm project with SINOHYDRO Renewable Energy, a full subsidiary of <a href="SINOHYDRO Corporation">SINOHYDRO Corporation</a>. Construction of the projects is expected to start in 2009.

The announcement was made at Econcern's Sustainable Energy Event running alongside the <u>UN Framework Convention on Climate Change</u> (UNFCCC) in Poznan, Poland – COP14.
